Discipline: Literacy Grade Level: 4-5



Activity 1: Insightful Inferences! (Appropriate for DURING the Broadcast Lesson)

Activity Goal: Use textual evidence to support inferences.

Targeted Literacy Skills: Inferencing

Materials: "A Dreamer's Dream" Poem - stanza 2, paper, and pencil.

Steps:

- 1. Read stanza 2 of "A Dreamer's Dream" poem.
- 2. Use your inferencing skills and textual evidence to answer the following question: What is the author trying to say about dreamers in stanza two?
- 3. Write down your response on your paper.

Activity 2: Inferencing Practice (Appropriate for AFTER the Broadcast Lesson)

Activity Goal: Use textual evidence to apply inferencing skills in everyday reading practices.

Targeted Literacy Skills: Inferencing

Materials: Any text, paper, and pencil.

Steps:

- 1. Read any fictional text.
- Use textual evidence to answer this question: The author is saying ______.
 I think this means _____. Write down your response on a piece of paper.
- Repeat this process in your daily reading practices (while reading fiction and beyond).
